Daily Growth

Use these 4C questions below to help you study each day's scripture.

CELEBRATE: What can you praise God for from this passage?

CONFESS: Are you convicted of something you need to confess to God?

COMMIT: What commitment does this passage challenge you to make?

COMMUNICATE: What did you learn that you can share with someone?

- Day 1: Read Luke 6:45, Luke 12:34, Colossians 3:15 and 1 Peter 3:15.

 After reading these verses what would you say is the role of the heart in your life from a biblical viewpoint? How are you feeding your heart? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
- Day 2: Read Romans 5:5, Ephesians 3:17, Hebrews 8:10, Colossians 3:1. What additional things do you learn about the role of the heart in your life and how are you to respond? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
- Day 3: Read Psalm 86:11. This is a short reading, but packed with meaning. Meditate on each phrase of this verse. What does each phrase mean to you? How much do you desire each of those things? How well are you doing in each of those areas? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
- Day 4: Read Nehemiah 1. What does Nehemiah's heart beat for? How is his passion expressed? How about you? What are you passionate about? How might God want to use that passion to point you in the direction He wants you to serve? Who shares your passion that you could team up with? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
- Day 5: Read 1 Thessalonians 2:7-12. What is Paul passionate about? How is his passion being expressed? How might your passions be expressed for God? Who can you share your passion with? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
- Day 6 Read Proverbs 4:23 and Proverbs 27:19. Memorize one or both of these verses and repeat it to yourself frequently, you'll be pleasantly surprised at how it will direct your decision-making and keep you out of trouble. What kind of heart is your life reflecting? How are you doing at protecting your heart this week? What is God saying to you (use the "4 C" questions)?
